

Standard Subscription License Terms

Introduction

These Standard Subscription License Terms (“Terms”) is entered into pursuant to, and is incorporated as part of, the Intratec’s [General Subscription Terms & Conditions](#).

Glossary

Definitions of terms hereby used can be found at Intratec’s [General Subscription Terms & Conditions](#).

In addition, in these terms:

“Business” means: any legal entity engaged in commercial, professional, charitable, or industrial activities. This includes both for-profit and nonprofit entities, such as corporations, partnerships, limited liability companies, trusts, foundations, and other organizations that operate to achieve specific goals or missions.

“For-Profit Business” means: any legal entity that is established with the primary objective of generating profit, which includes corporations, partnerships, limited liability companies, and other business entities engaged in commercial activities.

“Nonprofit Business” means: any legal entity not primarily focused on generating profit, established with objectives such as advancing public welfare, protecting the environment, or providing public services. This includes charities, foundations, governmental and international agencies.

“Educational Business” means: any legal entity that operates primarily to provide educational services or support. This includes colleges, universities, training centers, and other organizations dedicated to teaching, learning, and the dissemination of knowledge, whether they operate on a for-profit or nonprofit basis.

“Business Group” means: a set of For-Profit Business that includes both parent companies and their subsidiaries. Each entity within the group either controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with the others, where control is defined as ownership of more than 50% of assets or stock and having authority over daily operations.”

“Research-Related Publications” means: publications for academic research purposes not involving the performance of services for a fee or the production or manufacture of products for sale to third parties. Examples of Research-Related Publications include: academic journals, patents, thesis, scientific articles, technical articles, multi-lateral agency studies.

“Intra-Business Sharing” means: sharing of Licensed Materials, on a confidential basis, exclusively among employees of Customer, being Customer a For-Profit Organization.

“Business Group Sharing” means: sharing of Licensed Materials, on a confidential basis, exclusively among employees of Customer, being Customer a For-Profit Organization, and employees of other For-Profit Organizations belonging to the same Business Group.

License Types

Customer will be given access to Licensed Materials on an Ongoing | Starter License, an Ongoing | Pro License, or an Ongoing | Advanced License (each a ‘Standard License’) as stated on the Order Form and more specifically described in these terms. All Licenses are granted to the Customer named on the Order Form and may not be assigned or transferred.

“Ongoing | Starter License” means a type of license that allows the Customer’s Authorized Users to access the Licensed Materials from a unique country (identified in the Order Form). Proxy or community access from any other country not identified in the Order Form is strictly prohibited. This license allows Intra-Business Sharing restricted to employees of Customer located at Customer country.

“Ongoing | Pro License” means a type of license that allows the Customer’s Authorized Users to access the Licensed Materials without geographic restrictions. This license allows Intra-Business Sharing. Educational Businesses and Nonprofit Businesses are not eligible to purchase this type of license.

“Ongoing | Advanced License” means a type of license that allows the Customer’s Authorized Users to access the Licensed Materials without geographic restrictions. This license allows Business Group Sharing. Educational Businesses and Nonprofit Businesses are not eligible to purchase this type of license.

Use Restrictions

Internal Use

Customer or Authorized User may, in the course of its business, create Derived Content for internal use only, provided that: (i) the information and/or data from the Licensed Materials used in the Derived Content will be insubstantial and de minimis in nature and will not be primarily a copy of the Licensed Materials (ii) Customer or Authorized User undertakes not to create Derived Content that uses a portion of the Licensed Materials that could be considered substantial; (iii) Customer or Authorized User acknowledges Intratec as a source in relation to such Derived Content, as follows:

"Source: Intratec Solutions (www.intratec.us)"

where www.intratec.us should be a link redirecting to <https://www.intratec.us>, and (iv) Customer or Authorized User does not use or authorize the use of such Derived Content created in products/services that are competitive with Intratec Products.

Any use of Licensed Materials information and/or data beyond the restrictions outlined above would require a non-Standard license, which must be requested from Intratec.

Use in Research-Related Publications

Intratec data can only be used in Research-Related Publications upon prior written consent from Intratec.

Customers can at any time request Intratec to use minimal excerpts of Licensed Materials in Research-Related Publications. Intratec will evaluate each request on a case-by-case basis, based on the following criteria:

- a. The Intratec Information must be only a limited extract (i.e. an insubstantial amount of data provided only), restricted to 5 data points;
- b. The Intratec Information will be published only on an ad hoc, noncontinuous basis;
- c. Intratec must be identified as source, as follows: "Source: Intratec Solutions (www.intratec.us)", where www.intratec.us should be a link redirecting to <https://www.intratec.us>; and
- d. Customers interested in publishing Intratec data must submit a draft of the Research-Related Publication, including the Intratec data, to Intratec for evaluation. Only upon written consent from Intratec the Customer can use Intratec data.

Any use of Licensed Materials information and/or data beyond the restrictions outlined above would require a non-Standard license, which must be requested from Intratec.

Further Restrictions

For the avoidance of doubt and to the fullest extent permitted by law, the use of any Licensed Material in any manner other than the internal use described herein is strictly prohibited. Therefore, any Business entity whose core activities involve sharing information with third parties is not eligible to purchase standard licenses. Examples of such businesses include consulting companies, information services companies, and data resellers. Businesses with such profiles interested in accessing and using Licensed Materials must request a non-standard license from Intratec.

Educational Businesses and Nonprofit Businesses are allowed to purchase only Ongoing | Starter Licenses among the standard licenses available or can request a non-standard license.

In any case, Intratec reserves the right to refuse at any time or times to sell any sort of license to any Business.
